- During Sunday services, you will encounter friendly Greeters and Ushers at the church entrance to welcome all. They can assist you in finding your way before and after services. Please do not hesitate to introduce yourself to the Greeters and Ushers as a newcomer!
- Each of the pews has slots holding purple Welcome Cards. You can fill out one of these cards to indicate your interest in obtaining more information about Grace St. Paul's. This will give us an opportunity to get to know you better and serve your special needs or inquiries. The Welcome Card may be placed in the alms basin or given to an Usher or Greeter at the end of the service.
- All are welcome to participate in Communion at Grace St. Paul's, regardless of tradition or belief.
- Following the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. services on Sunday, you are welcome join us for coffee and snacks in McBride Hall, adjacent to the church itself.
- As you enter McBride Hall, you will find a Welcome Table to your left. This table is stocked with all kinds of information about our parish and is staffed by members of the Welcoming Newcomers Ministry. Please stop by to introduce yourself and ask any questions you might have!
- A guest registry is located in the narthex, just as you enter the front of the church. You may sign this register with your name, current city/state and parish to show us that you visited.
